

ATTENTION MILAN PARK USERS

We are opening the park beginning Tuesday, June 16, 2020--WITH LIMITATIONS. The restrooms and playground equipment are not to be used and will be closed and taped off due to an abundance of caution to combat the spread of COVID-19.

In addition, please at a minimum observe the following rules and guidelines while in the park:

- 1) Do not use the parks if you are sick with COVID-19, tested positive for COVID-19 (with or without symptoms), or you were recently exposed to the Virus.
- 2) Practice Social Distancing: Keep 6-7 feet apart from others not in your party
- 3) Please wipe down picnic tables with disinfectant wipes or cleaning spray of some kind before and after use. This protects you and your fellow users!
- 4) Bring and use hand sanitizer often
- 5) Make sure to pick up any trash and dispose of it properly (a normal requirement, but of extra importance during this time of heightened cleanliness!).
- 6) Consider coming back at another time if the park is crowded so that social distancing is not possible.
- 7) Although not mandatory, we encourage all to wear a face mask that covers your nose and mouth when possible and when the 6-7 foot social distancing cannot be consistently maintained.

And as always, please continue practicing all the other recommended precautions the State and CDC recommend to combat the spread of COVID-19!
